



Call for Student Assistants under supervision of BuildMoNa Doctoral Candidates

The Graduate School BuildMoNa offers the possibility to its Doctoral Candidates to supervise a Student Assistant within a self-defined "mini-project".

The idea behind this is to strengthen supervision skills of the BuildMoNa Doctoral Candidates and to attract the attention for the scientific activities in BuildMoNa of motivated students with an excellent Bachelor that wish to do some additional lab work.

The "mini-project" shall be planned by the BuildMoNa Doctoral Candidate with a maximum work time of 200 hours for the Student Assistant, who will be paid according the "SHK" rate. The weekly working time is at maximum 19 hours for the Student Assistant.

The Student Assistant shall have a B.Sc. (or equivalent) with grade 1.9 or better. The "mini-project" shall be terminated before the start of the Diploma or Master Thesis of the Student Assistant.

The Doctoral Candidate should submit the "mini-proposal" as PDF file via email to the BuildMoNa Office (buildmona@uni-leipzig.de) containing the following documents:

- description of the "mini-project" (max. 1 page)
- short letter of recommendation from the Doctoral Candidate for the proposed Student Assistant (1/2 page)
- CV of the proposed Student Assistant
- Transcript of Bachelor Certificate (with grade) of the proposed Student Assistant

The deadline for the next round of proposals is Thursday, 23 September 2010.

The BuildMoNa Steering Committee will then decide on the proposals.
