Science writing as a career for PhD scientists

Writing about science in a nonacademic setting is different, and serves a different purpose, than academic writing. A postdoc in biophysics was the launch pad for my move to science journalism, and in this presentation I will discuss aspects of communicating that are key to science writing, the day-to-day work of a science writer, and how stories are developed from ideas to published pieces. I will also discuss some of the paths to become a science writer, the wide interdisciplinary interest and other requirements for success, and the types of jobs open to science writers, as well as mention some "sister" careers.
